

State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Nancy Williams
of Guenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of thirty dollars to
me paid by Mary Stone of the State and district aforesaid have granted
bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said Mary Stone fifteen acres and one half of land be the same
more or less situate in Guenville District lying on mountain Creek water
of Saluda River being her full distributive share of the land left by Jonathan
Stone Decd to his children Together with all and singular the Rights, members
hereditaments ^{and appurtenances} to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to
Have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said
Mary Stone her heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind my self my heirs
Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Mary Stone her heirs and assigns against my
self and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand
and seal this twenty eight day of January in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and twelve and in the thirty sixth year of
the independence of the United States of America.

and subscribed before me this first day of March 1812.
