we William Roberts and James Sur. of the State & district aforesaid for & in  
consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to us in hand paid  
by Leonard Dozier of the district & state aforesaid have granted  
the aforesaid sold & released and by these presents do grant & again sell  
and release unto the said Leonard Dozier one certain tract or parcel  
of land lying & being in the state & district aforesaid on both sides  
of Mountain Creek of Enoree River including a saw mill being  
a part of a tract of land surveyed for James Carnes & granted to  
him by his Excellency Thomas Bennett Esqr bearing date 6<sup>th</sup> day of August  
1821 Beginning on a post oak corner thence an east course to a hickory  
thence nearly a south course to a stake thence a west course to a stake thence  
a north course to the water of said mill pond and up the same to the  
head of said Pond and down the other side to a large stone near a  
spring thence a north course to the beginning containing eight acres  
be the same more or less including all ground that the water covers  
by the dam of S<sup>d</sup> Saw Mill that is now made or by any that may here-  
after be made together with all and singular the rights members her-  
editaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining To have & To Hold all & singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Leonard Dozier his heirs & assigns  
for ever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors &
