 tion of the sum of three hundred dollars paid by James Cox of the State aforesaid
 have granted and doth by these presents sell and release to said James Cox one
 hundred and fifteen acres of land more or less lying in Greenville District on each
 side of the Long Branch of Rocky Creek waters of Reedy River it being a part of a
 tract of land belonging to the estate of James Seaborn deceased and sold at
 his sale the land to be conveyed Beginning an 803x on Balwens line N. 41 W 78
 to a hickory bush 3x then 74 w 45 to a Stake 3x at the head of a branch thereof
 down the meanders of said branch to a persimmon 3x then to a pine 3x
 on James Cox's line then with sd line to the beginning exceeding one
 hundred and fifteen acres be the same more or less together with
 all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances
 to the sd premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to
 have or to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
 the said James Cox and I do hereby bind my self my heirs and executors
 and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the premises above mentioned unto the sd James Cox his heirs and assigns —
 forever against myself my heirs and against every other person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof —
 In witness whereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of Nov-
 ember Anno thousand eight hundred and twenty two signed and deli-
 vered in the presence of J. D. Moon, B. Henderson ^{John H.} Moore ^{mark}

 sideration of the sum of twenty two dollars paid by James Cox of the State
 aforesaid have granted and doth by these presents sell and release to the
 said James Cox acres of land more or less lying in Greenville District on the
 Long Branch waters of Reedy River it being part of a tract of land originally
 granted to James Seaborn deceased lying as follows Beginning on a per-
 simmon running with meander of the Branch a North course to a sweet gum
 thence South West to a white oak thence South East to a sassafras thence
 east to the beginning corner exceeding ten acres more or less together with
 all and singular that appertaining to sd land and premises before men-
 tioned to the sd James Cox his heirs and assigns forever I the sd Richard H.
 Askew doth hereby bind my ^{self} heirs and assigns to warrant and forever
 defend the aforescribed land and premises to the sd James Cox
 his heirs and assigns from all claims that now is or may be made by any
 persons or persons what so ever claiming the same or any part thereof in
 witness whereunto set my hand and seal this 30th day of November 1822
