

South Carolina Whereas James Hooker have become indebted to Greenville District William Hall two hundred dollars for which I give him possession of my land and dwellings where I now live from this time until the 25th December eighteen hundred and twenty seven Now know all men by these presents that I James Hooker in order to secure the said William Hall with a good warrant due to the said tract of land wherein the said James Hooker now lives supposed to contain one hundred and ten acres more or less and in consideration of the said W. Hall having this mortgage he gives his note for one sixty seven dollars payable the 25th day of December 1826 the other for sixty seven & 50 cents dollars payable the 25th of December 1827 which is to complete at the last payment for the said tract of land then if the said Hooker shall truly make a cause to be made the said William Hall all his heirs executors administrators a good warrant due at the time that he receives the last payment then this mortgage or bill of sale to be void or else proceed to the sale of the same in order to discharge the said debt as the law directs returning the over plus if any to the said Hooker to witness my hand and seal this 5 day of December 1825.

South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Sam'l Walker of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five to me in hand paid by James Watson of the district and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said James Watson a plantation or tract of land lying on being situated in the district and State aforesaid on in water of Rocky Creek it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to the said Samuel Walker and now conveyed to James Watson Beginning on a forked Post Oak Runing S 25 E 22.50 to a Black Jack N 47 E 28.50 to Rock thence S 48 E 19.50 to a Pin thence S 8 W 20 to Stake thence S 17 W 22.50 to Post oak thence N 60 W 41 to a red Oak thence N 33 E h to Post oak thence to the beginning Inclinding three hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Watson and I do bind myself my heirs executors to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said James Watson his heirs and assigns forever against myself and myself and against every other person whom so ever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof whereof I have hereunto set my hand seal this July 1822 Just Lyn Walker, Sam'l Watson & Samuel Walker
