Francis Adams a tract or plantation of land lying and being in the Dist. of Greenville aforesd on both sides of Middle Tyger River Beginning at a Post Oak known by a corner of Ann Eastways corner tract thence with the line of that Survey N. 63 ch to a light wood Stake and in the same course N. 70. ch to a knotty Black Oak thence W. 20 ch to a Chestnut on a survey made for Bearden thence N. 90. with his line 1 ch n. 80. Stks. to a white Oak his corner thence west with his line to the upper end of the big bove and thence a straight line to the mouth of a branch entering in to the Middle Fork of Tyger River be cause the will now
