 three original tracts one granted to John Winn for 640 acres one other granted
 to Roobham Luttrell for 65 acres the other granted to John Buchanan and lying
 on the the State and District aforesaid on the North side of reedy River beginning
 on a beach near said River thence running East 25.50 to a cack 3+ thence North
 10 to a red oak 3+ binding on Scipio Pedens land thence East 30 to a stake 3+ binding
 on P. Scipio and John Pedens land thence South 10 to a stake 3+ thence east 11 to a
 stake 3+ thence South 46 to a white oak 3+ thence S. 65. 10. 45th a red oak 3+ thence
 thence South 5 to a hickory 3+ near the head of Paul Ramseys Spring branch and
 bounded by William Choices land thence down the meanders of the said
 Branch to the said reedy River thence up the meanders of said River to the begin-
 ning together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and
 appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
 ing to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
