Redens then continuing the same line N.60.W.78. to a red oak bound by William C. Givens Land then S.26.W.5.50. to a red oak thence S.70.E.9. to a Stake thence thence N.69.E.12.26. to a poplar and a branch thence down the meanders of said branch to the beginning including one hundred and ninety seven acres of land be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Micajah Berry, his heirs and assigns forever provided never the less and upon conditions, that if the said Fleming Hatcher his heirs Executors or Administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Micajah Berry, his certain attorney, Executors, administrators, or assigns the full and just sum of two hundred and fifty dollars on or before the first day of March next with interest from the date hereof then and in such case, and at all times from thence fourth these presents and all the estate hereby granted and every article clause and sentence therein contained shall cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding witness my hand and seal this 3 day of December A.D. 1825.

The State of South Carolina Greenville District know all men by these presents That I Hewlet Sullivan of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Micajah Berry in the State and District aforesaid have granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Micajah Berry a parcel or tract of land lying in the State and District aforesaid on Reedy River on the south side of sd river being part of a tract of land originally granted to John Winn for 640 acres on the 16 day of July 1784 and Recorded in grant Book A.A.A.C. page 57 thence conveyed from said Winn through several hands to said Sullivan now from said Sullivan to said Berry the said parcel of land beginning on a sweet gum at the river thence running E.74. W.39 to a white oak 3rd thence S.13.E.2 to a red oak 3rd thence S.41.E.5 to an ash 3rd thence N.78.E.8.50. to a hickory 3rd thence East 5.50. to a white oak 3rd thence S.85.E.6 to a black gum 3rd thence S.50.E.6 to a Spanish oak 3rd on the river then up the meanders of said river to the beginning including forty acres of land be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned in said
