South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that William Pollard of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Dunn of the District and State aforesaid have Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Benjamin Dunn a certain tract of Land containing One hundred and twenty acres less the same more or less Lying in the District and State of aforesaid on the South Side of Reedy River it being a tract of land originally Granted to James Pease and a part of a tract originally Granted to Mr. Williams the Land is laid out to the said Benjamin Dunn as follows Bounded N. E. by Land originally Granted to Hugh Roark until it intersects with the S. Armstrong line thence N. E. with said line to the said Reedy River then up the meanders of sd river to a conditional corner willow oak corner a ground in the presence of John Smith and Isaac Hilde thence along a conditional line south westward to a Stake corner in a post oak stump thence S. Westward along a conditional line until it intersects with the course of a line known by the name of Lendmans old line to a corner thence south westward to the original Stake corner of sd Lendmans line thence with said line 40. 33 to a Stake corner on John Pyles line thence S. E. 30° 43' to a Stake corner thence S. E. 43° 27' to the beginning corner on Roarks line together with all and singular the right members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging to me in any wise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Dunn his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators by warrant and for ever defend all and singular the sd one hundred and twenty acres more or less with the premises unto the said Benjamin Dunn his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and all and every other person or persons whomever claiming the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st day of November 1818 Test John Smith Isaac ^{his} Hilde ^{mark} William Pollard Seal
