I Thomas Edwards of the State and Dist. aforesaid do bargain sell and release
unto William Miller a tract of Land lying in the State and District
aforesaid and on both sides of Kemp's Branch of Enoree River containing
One hundred and Seventeen acres for and in the sum of two
hundred Dollars to him the said Edwards in hand paid beginning at a
White Oak tree on Uriah Canners line west to a red oak thereabouts
a crop Kemp's branch at the mouth of a little branch and thence up
the East side of the branch to a small post oak thence East to a post oak on
Canners land thence to the beginning corner the white oak together with all the
premises and appurtenances thereto I the said Thomas Edwards do warrant and
defend my self myself signs Executors and Administrators whomever
may claim challenging or demand unto William Miller his heirs and
assigns for ever to have and to hold the premises in witness my hand and
seal this the 30th December and in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and
Sixteen ³ T. Mathew Hudson Edmond Miller Thomas ^{his} Edwards ^{Seal}
