State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I John Grice of the one part for And in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars in hand to me paid by Greens Berry Capps of the other Part both of the State and District aforesaid have Granted bargained sold and Delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Greensberry Capps all and singular that part of the Land purchased by the said Grice West of the top of the high hill next to Johnathan Potts now lives and the mill containing two hundred acres be the same more or less to be run on a boundary line to run straight at the top of said hill where the road crosses the hill and include all the land to the west sold to said land with the mill & plantation or said land & bounded by Raleigh Hood and Joseph Mayfields land, including the mouth of Fall and Gap creeks and lying on both sides of the meanders forks of Saluda, together with all and singular the said premises unto the said Greensberry Capps his heirs and assigns for ever and I do here by bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators each and every one of them to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Greensberry Capps his heirs & assigns Against my self & my heirs and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof by testament Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 5 of November 1823 signed sealed in the presence of us John Grice
