which sum with interest thereon from this date the said James Pickett holds  
my hand in the penal sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars with a condition to be  
void upon the payment of the said sum of Ten Thousand and four hundred  
Dollars and interest from the date in ten equal annual instalments of one ten  
Part and the annual interest upon the whole, and to secure the payment of which  
the said William H. Salmon have bargained and sold and by the  
present do bargain and sell and in plain and open market deliver  
unto the said James Pickett and his heirs the following Slave that
