 Assigns and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever
 Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness
 whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the Twentieth of May one thousand
 Eight hundred and twenty five signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
William Lynch Peter Edwards Geo. Salmon

 The said William H. Salmon owe and stand justly indebted to James Pickett
 of Greenville District and State of aforesaid in the just and full sum of Ten
 Thousand four hundred dollars Good and Lawfull money of the said State for
 which sum with interest thereon from this date the said James Pickett holds
 my hand in the penal sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars with a condition to be
 void upon the payment of the said sum of Ten Thousand and four hundred
 Dollars and interest from the date in Ten equal annual instalments of one thousand
 Part and the annual interest upon the whole, and to secure the payment of which
 The said William H. Salmon have bargained and sold and by these
 presents do bargain and sell and in plain and open market deliver
 unto the said James Pickett and his heirs the following Slaves that
