The State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these  
Presents that I Samuel Forester of the District and State aforesaid  
for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me  
In hand paid by Benajah Dunham of the same place the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed  
and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said Benajah  
Dunham and his heirs and assigns forever four certain negro slaves  
namely a negro woman Grace and witet Moses and Louisa  
children of the said Grace with all and singular the future increase  
of the said negroes or any of them being the same negro woman with  
her increase which was willed and bequeathed by Samuel Kelly to  
Maryan Kelly his widow to have and to hold during her natural  
Life then to be and returned to me as my right and property the other  
negroes named in the increase of the said Grace. Now it expressly and  
understood and agreed as a part of this instrument that the said above named  
negroes and their future increase shall be continue and remain  
with the said Maryan Kelly now Maryan Duncan she having  
married Robert Duncan for and during her natural life then to be  
and become the property of the said Benajah Dunham and his heirs  
forever in as full and as ample a manner as they would vest in me by  
virtue of the will of the said Samuel Kelly to have and to hold him  
and his heirs forever against me and my heirs and against every  
other person claiming or to claim the same or any of the said negroes  
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns  
to warrant and forever defend the said negroes with their future increase  
against every person whomsoever In testamancy whereof I hereunto
