 Under my hand and Seal this 27<sup>th</sup> April 1819 and in the forty third  
 year of American Independence signed sealed and delivered in presence  
 of sd William Gilbert James Thomas Crymes. Sarah Jackson <sup>with</sup> sealed  
 South Carolina Green with District Personally came Thomas  
 Crymes before me one of the Justices of the peace for said District  
 & made oath in due form of and saith on said oath that he  
 was present and saw Sarah Jackson sign and deliver the within  
 deed of Conveyance to William M Crymes for the use and purpose  
 therein mentioned and that he also saw William Gilbert James sign the  
 same as a concurring witness with himself sworn to and subscribed  
 Before me <sup>the</sup> 23 day of August 1819 John Sims J.P. & Thomas Crymes  
 I Recorded for the 3 April 1826

 presents that I Edward Howard of the State of Georgia Decolb  
 County for and in the consideration of the sum of three hundred  
 and twelve Dollars to me in hand paid by Asa Wright of the state  
 and District of foresaid have Bargained sold and released and by  
 these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said  
 Asa Wright all that plantation or tract of Land containing one  
 Hundred and Eighty four Acres situate in State and District for  
 said on the Branches of Durbin's Waters of Enoree river originally  
 Granted to James Stapp William P. Riddle and John Steel Butting  
 and Bounding as follows (viz) beginning on a Stake 3+ thence  
 N 38 E 29 to a white oak 3+ thence S 9 W 4 to a red oak 3+ thence S 75 E  
 5-50 to a red oak 3+ thence S 52 E 36 to a Post oak 3+ on thence S 38 W 25  
 to a Spanish oak 3+ thence S 12 to a Stake 3+ thence N 21 50 to a Post  
 Oak 3+ thence S 78 E 15 to a Post oak 3+ thence N 52 W 10 to the State  
 to the beginning to include one Hundred and Eighty four  
 acres be the same more or Less Together with all and  
 Singular the rights members Hereditaments and appur-  
 tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident  
 or appertaining to have and to hold forever and I Edward  
 Howard do hereby bind myself and my heirs Executors  
 Administrators or assigns to warrant and forever defend the  
 same unto Asa Wright his heirs and assigns from the Lawfull  
 Claim of any person or persons whatsoever in witness whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of December  
 One thousand Eight hundred and twenty five and forty  
 sixth year of American independence signed sealed and delivered  
 in the presence of sd William Gilbert John Parrish & Edward Howard  
 N.B. the above Butting and bounding as follows by Samuel Thompson  
 John Mency John Howard and James Canaday Land.
