The State of South Carolina⁹⁴ Know all men by these presents that I Berryman Hawkins Greenville District³ of the State of South Carolina one of the heirs and legatees of the estate of Eaton Hawkins deceased of the above named place for and in the consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to me paid by Jeremiah Cleveland of the State & district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell & release all my part of the real estate coming to me from my Father the above named Eaton Hawkins dec'd whom my mother now lives the wife and widow of my Father the said Eaton Hawkins died all my part Interest or claim the said Real Estate viz the lands said to contain two hundred acres lying and being in the State & district aforesaid on the waters of Reedy River and adjoining the land of Park Hawkins, Mr Wayne & Others near Parcys Mountain, and it is expressly understood that I the said Berryman Hawkins do by these presents that it is the intent & meaning of this instrument to convey unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland all the interest I have in the above mentioned estate to which I am any wise intitled by the last will and testament of the said Eaton Hawkins as fully as if this Conveyance were more fully and clearly expressed together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises or any part thereof which I have Conveyed belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend the said premises to the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against all persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof I testify whereof I have hereunto set my name and have affixed my seal the 11 day of April 1826. signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
