Whereas by virtue of a Writ issued from the Court of Ordinary for this district
and State dated the Nineteenth day of December in the Year of our Lord One
Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty five in order to make division between the
heirs of John Traum deceased to me directed to advertise a certain Tract

and provided and for and in considerations of the said sum of Two Hundred
dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Huolitt Sullivan
the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, Have Granted
bargained and sold and by these presents do Grant bargain and sell unto the
said Huolitt Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever the said Tract piece and
parcel of Land with its appurtenances and all the Estate right title and
interest which the said John Traum deceased of right had of in or to the same
to have and to hold the said piece parcel and Tract of Land unto the said Huolitt
Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said Nivrod
Underwood might could or ought to Grant Bargain and sell the same by
virtue of the act of the General Assembly aforesaid or otherwise.
