of two hundred dollars to me paid by John Morgan of the State and district aforesaid
have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said John Morgan all that plantation or tract of land
situate in the district of Greenville bounding on the south side of Fall Creek waters
of Saluda River butting and bounding on the rich mountain beginning at a Stake running
running south west to a Stake thence south east to a Stake near bains line thence
along the steep part of the mountain between Morgans field and bains line
to Ford line thence to the beginning containing two hundred acres more
or less originally granted to John Elledge by patent bearing date the
2^d day of December 1793 also one other plantation or tract of land contain-
ing fifty acres more or less situate in the district aforesaid part of a
three hundred and thirty acre tract lying on the waters of Fall Creek waters
of Saluda River beginning at a line at the conditional line between Stephen
and Thomas Morgan running a south west direction across a branch on
to a second branch to a stake thence a north west direction on a conditional
line between John Corbin and Stephen Morgan to a Blazed Spanish Oak
