 of four hundred dollars current money of the United States paid by Josiah Bulletron
 junior, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge to have given granted, bargained
 and sold and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell a clear release convey and con-
 firm unto the said Josiah Bulletron junior his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece
 or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville district South Carolina designated
 bounded buted and described as follows to wit beginning at a post oak corner being the South
 East corner of a survey of eight hundred and twenty two acres originally granted to Wil-
 liam Davis Thomas thence north 46° East to George Salmons corner thence westwardly
 along said Salmon's line to his South West corner at or near the head of the Rocky
 branch thence south five west to the South boundary line of said Thomas Survey; thence
 East along said line to the said place of beginning containing two hundred acres
 More or less To Have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises
 with the privileges and appurtenances thereof and thereto belonging to him the
 said Josiah Bulletron junior his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper
 use benefit and behoof forever and we the said Josiah Bulletron senior and
 Martha the wife of the said Josiah, for our debts our heirs executors and administrato-
 tors, do covenant to and with said Josiah Bulletron junior his heirs executors, administrators
 and assigns that at and until the sealing hereof we were and are lawfully seized and
 possessed of the above described premises in fee simple that they are free of all en-
 cumberances that we have good right and lawful authority to sell and convey the
 same to the said Josiah Bulletron junior in manner and form aforesaid and that
 we will warrant and forever defend the same to the said Josiah Bulletron junior his
 heirs and assigns against all lawfull claims and demands of any person or persons
