

The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Joel Clardy  
of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Sixty five dollars  
to me paid by James Bennie of the same place in the State aforesaid have granted,  
bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto  
the said James Bennie a certain piece parcel or tract of land situate in the district  
and State aforesaid on the waters of Rudy River containing by estimation one hun-  
dred and thirteen be the same more or less as follows beginning on a maple 3x. S 10.  
E 36. Stake 3x. S. 50 E. 18. Hickory 3x. N. 85 E. 20. to a Hickory 3x. N. 17 W. 17. to a hickory 3x. N. 5. W. 17 to  
a stake 3x. thence to the beginning maple corner being part of a tract of land  
granted to young Griffin bearing date the first of September 1794. and can  
veyed through different hands down to me and recorded in the Clerk office  
to me in book H pages 259 & 260. for the 25 day of November 1822 —  
Together with all and singular the Rights, immunities, hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Bennie his  
heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and adminis-  
trators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said James Bennie his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and  
against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this eleventh day  
of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
ninety six and in the fifty first year of the American Independence

of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Jeremiah Cleveland of the district of Greenville  
South Carolina have granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland a certain tract or parcel of land lying in  
the district of Greenville aforesaid bounded and described as follows viz beginning at a post oak  
corner being the south east corner of Survey of Eight hundred and seventy two acres originally  
granted to William D Thomas thence N. 26 East to George Salmon's corner thence Eastwardly along  
George Salmon's line to his south west corner at or near the head of Rock branch thence Sow  
five 5 West to the south boundary five of the said Thomas Survey, thence East a long said line to the  
said place of beginning the above being a part of the original Survey to Wm D Thomas bearing  
date the third day of March in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred and Eighty Eight  
and containing two hundred acres more or less was transferred from Wm D Thomas to Josiah  
Culbertson Senior and from Josiah Culbertson Senior and his wife to Josiah Culbertson Junior  
to have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with the privileges  
and appurtenances therof or in any manner belonging to the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs  
and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to
