ation of six hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander McKinney
the rest whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Alexander
McKinney all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district
aforesaid on the Medow fork of Musc Creek waters of South Tiger River —
beginning on a hickory rising S. 45° E. 48.50 to a stake thence S. W. to a post oak —
thence N. 20° E. 34.60 thence N. E. to the beginning corner containing one hundred
and fifty acres more or less it being part of a tract of land containing two
hundred acres of land granted unto Thomas Lavery by his Excellency William
Moultrie on the twenty sixth day of April one thousand seven hundred
and eighty six having such shapes forms marks & Buttings as appears by
the plat to the said Grant annexed together with all and singular the rights
and number hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said
premises unto the said Alexander McKinney his heirs and assigns for ever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns
to warrant and for ever defend unto the said Alexander McKinney his
heirs and assigns all and singular the above mentioned premises
against myself and my heirs and against every other person lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this nineteenth day of November one thousand
Eight hundred and twenty five and in the fifteenth year of the sovereignty
and independence of the United States of America (with line from the top
entitler before aforesaid in the word Acres Impresence
of Robert Nelson, Benj. Molin
