of Grunville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Two hundred and thirty five  
dollars to me paid by James Hooker in the district and State aforesaid have granted bar  
gained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said James Hooker a certain plantation or tract of land containing one hundred  
acres lying in the District aforesaid on a branch of Mountain Creek of Enoree  
River and hath such boundaries as the plat of said represents whereas it begining  
an a box oak corner thence S 17 W 12 to a stake corner thence E 84.50 to the begining  
it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Forrest Hudson decd.  
The premises together with all and singular the rights number hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or  
pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the sd James Hooker his heirs and assigns for ever and I do  
hereby bind myself my heirs exec and admo to warrant & forever defend  
all and singular the sd premises unto the said James Hooker his heirs and  
assigns & against myself and my heirs and against every other person whom  
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
Witness my hand and seal this 4<sup>th</sup> day of March one thousand eight hundred  
and twenty six and in the fiftieth year of the independence  
of the United States of America

all that tract or parcel of land being in the district aforesaid on  
Buck Horn Creek a branch of Enoree River lines begining on a trout.
