the date of this of gift as well as the consideration of one dollar to me in  
hand paid by the said Charles Littleton and it is Expressly understood that  
the said negro boy Jackson as aforesaid to be and remain in the possession  
of the said Semima Littleton during her natural life time and then to begin  
up to the said Charles Littleton my dear son, hereby warranting and  
Confirming the said Negro boy Jackson as aforesaid. In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day  
of Decr. in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty  
six and in the fifteenth year of American Independence in presence  
of James Hawkins, Alexander Aulay Semima <sup>her</sup> Littleton  
mark

Grunville District he was present and saw Semima Littleton sign & deliver  
the within deed to Charles Littleton for the use & purpose therein mentioned  
also saw Alex Aulay sign with himself as a subscribing witness to the same
