Grenville District } Simmons and Mary Simmons of the aforesaid State and
district for and in Consideration of the sum of fifty dollars paid by James Roberts of the
aforesaid district and state aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and released and by
these presents do grant bargain & sell and release unto the said James Roberts a
certain tract or piece of land containing twenty five acres lie the same more or less
it being part of a tract of land originally granted to Hardin Roberts and bounded as
follows. Beginning at a black Oak thence a straight line to a black Oak by the
path side that leads between said John Simmons & James Roberts to a black oak
corner thence a conditional marked line to a black Oak corner on Hardin Roberts line
thence with said line nearly East to the conditional line between John Simmons and
James Roberts thence with James Roberts line to the beginning corner together with
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the
said premises belonging to have and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said James Roberts his heirs and assigns for ever
and we do hereby bind our selves, see his executors and administrators to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Roberts
his heirs and assigns for ever and against every person whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness our hands &
Seals this fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and five signed sealed and delivered in presence
of Robert Mcafee, Joseph ^{his} Callahan, John Simmons ^{Seal}
