The State of South Carolina know all men by these presents that we Garland Walker and Elizabeth Walker lately Elizabethe Carter of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to us in hand paid by Allan R. Perkins of the district and state aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Allan R. Perkins all their Right title interest and estate of inheritance which we have been or may be entitled to as one of the heirs legatus and distributees of the real estate and lands of the late Joseph Carter deceased, the father of the said Elizabeth Walker, consisting of the one fourth part of the four hundred and eighty five acres better known now or by which has never been measured and meted off in parcels to each legatus but is included in the deed of Conveyance from the above named Garland Walker to Samay Walker bearing date the 31st of October A.D. 1822 and all the interest and estate of inheritance hereby now conveyed was in and by that deed intended to be conveyed situated lying and being in the said district of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of Rudy River and for a more particular description of the whole tract of which our part as one of the heirs of the said Joseph Carter deceased is hereby fully conveyed and released we refer to the deed from Garland Walker to Samay Walker and from him to Allan R. Perkins as our integral part is included in both of those deeds and is a part of the land by them conveyed together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Allan R. Perkins his heirs and assigns for ever And we do hereby bind our selves, our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Allan R. Perkins his heirs and assigns, against ourselves and our heirs, and against every person whom soever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof Intertwings and seals this twenty third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven and in the fifty first year of the Independence of the United States of America signed sealed and delivered in the presence of John E.
