Greenville District Walker of the State & district aforesaid for and in con-
sideration of the sum of Two Hundred & fifty dollars paid by John Townsend of the
district & State aforesaid have bargained & sold & by these presents do bargain & sell
& release to the said John Townsend all that tract or parcel & plantation of land
whereon goes Moon river line containing one hundred and thirty eight
acres more or less lying in Greenville District on a branch of the Rudy Fork of
Rudy River being a part of a tract of Land granted to Jacob Walder
James assigned by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the 3rd of December
1787. also a part of a tract granted to Robt Gillam assigned by his Ex-
cellency Thomas Pinckney on the 7th of April 1788. the 100 acre hundred &
thirty eight acres of Land laid out to the Dr John Townsend as follows
beginning on a pine corner on James line a mess line running N. 55 W.
9 to a Hickory thence N. 33 E. 15. 25. to a post O. thence N. 33 W. 55. to a stake on
Samuel Ballings line thence N. 28 E. 9. 50 to a post O. thence S. 62 E. 53. to a post O
on Richard Lester line thence N. 6. E. 12 to a Poplar & thence to the Beginning
including the whole land to be conveyed together with all that appertains to the
so land or premises or in anywise incident to have and to hold unto the Dr John
Townsend his heirs & assigns for ever & lastly I do hereby bind myself my heirs -
Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend the so land together with
all and singular the rights, members, hundaments, & appurtenances unto
the said Dr Townsend, belanning or appertaining thereto. to John Townsend
his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs & assigns also from all other
persons or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof -
