 River North side of sd River Beginning at a persimmon 3x on  
 the bank of the River thence N.45. E. 8. to a Post. old thence N.5.  
 E. 26 to a post oak 3x old thence S.45. E. 15.5 to a post oak 3x  
 thence S.25. W. 21. to a pine stump 3x thence S.61. E. 5.60 to a post oak  
 sapling 3x old thence S.23. W. 8.75 to a pine 3x old thence S.42. E. 35.50  
 to a stone 3x thence S.5. E. 3.75 to a hickory sprout 3x thence 65. west 5 to  
 a hickory tree 3x old thence S.38. W. 3.50 to a maple 3x old on the  
 back of the River thence up the meanders of the River  
 aforesaid to a white Oak 3x thence S. 80. to the west 3 ch to a red oak 3x  
 new thence up the River to the Beginning containing one hundred  
 thirty five acres to have and to hold the same unto the said that  
 Thursto his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs exec-  
 tors and administrators and assigns to warrant & forever defend the above descri-  
 bed premises from me & my heirs and every other person or persons lawfully  
 claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 1827 in  
the presence of us William Thursto Govt. William Fuller & Elijah Pike  
 Personally came before me the Subscribing Justice William Thursto senior and  
 saith saith on his oath that he saw Elijah Pike sign seal and deliver  
 the written deed unto that Thursto for the purpose aforesaid  
 Sworn to & subscribed before me this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 1827.

 ning at a white oak on the so. bank of the River on a line of land  
 formerly owned by Julius Nichols died thence N.30. W. 25. ch. to a  
 red Oak thence S. 60. E. 11. ch to a red oak thence S. 76. W. 32. ch running  
 with Pander road to a Post. oak and small chestnut by the n. side  
 of the road thence N. 24. 6ch to a small persimmon & pine knot  
 thence N. 0. 7. E. 14 ch. 50 ft. to a hickory near the fence of the plantation  
 attached to the Estate of James Blasingame thence with the direction  
 of the fence to the River thence with the meanders thereof to the be-  
 gining containing by Estimation one hundred acres the  
 same more or less the same being part of a survey granted  
 to Michael Miller by Patent bearing date Jan'y 1<sup>st</sup> 1785 and by
