State of South Carolina. I know all men by these presents that I Jacob Wilson
of Greenville District in the state aforesaid in consideration of the sum of four hundred
dollars to me in hand paid by Timothy H. Keuler have granted bargained sold and
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Timot
-by H Keuler his heirs and assigns for ever the following tract or parcel of land
situated on the Enore River in the district and state aforesaid to wit - one tract
supposed to contain five acres more or less and lying on both sides of Enore
River beginning at a Hickory on the East side of said River thence up the
River to a red oak corner thence still up the River to a nother Red oak
corner thence north to a white oak thence North to a nother white oak
at a stake thence N.W. to a Sapprad corner thence to the River to a maple corner
thence down the River to the beginning including three fourths of an acre on
the west side of the River at an old Mill seat it being the same tract
which was conveyed to the said Jacob by John Pike by deed dated the
8th March 1822 also all that other tract or parcel of land situated in the
District and State aforesaid on the North side of Enore River supposed
to contain one hundred and ninety nine acres more or less and
beginning on a dogwood on the fork of said River thence East to a red
Oak Saplin thence to a chunut thence E. to a post oak stump thence S. to a
pine thence N. to a black Oak thence W. to a Maple on the bank of the
River thence up the River winding as the River to the beginning. To have and to
hold the said tracts of land together with all and singular the Rights, Hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Timothy H. Keuler his heirs and assigns for ever and I do here by bind myself my heirs Executors
and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the
said Timothy H. Keuler his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and any other person
or person who shall lawfully claiming the same or any part. Witness my hand and seal this
23^d day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
six and in the fiftieth year of American independence signed sealed & delivered in
