Know all men by these presents that we William Mulin of Humphreys County and State of Tennessee and John Mulin of Hopkins County and State of Kentucky Legatees of the estate of John Mulin late of Greenville District and State of South Carolina deceased in consideration of the sum of One thousand six hundred dollars to Benjamin Mulin in hand paid by Alexander McKinney of Greenville District aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have granted bargained sold released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell release convey and confirm unto the said Alexander McKinney his heirs and assigns all our respective right Title interest claim and demand of in or to a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation two hundred and fifty five acres be the same more or less situated in Greenville district aforesaid on both sides of the South fork of Tyger River being the same plantation wheron the said deceased last resided being the whole tract of two hundred and five acres of land granted to John Collins the twenty first day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty five and now as follows Beginning at a red oak on the North side of the South fork of Tyger River thence due North fifty two chains to a post oak thence South forty four degrees west fifty eight chains and fifty links to a red oak thence South fifteen degrees East thirty six chain to a red oak thence South sixty eight degrees west seventy chains to a red oak thence to the beginning out of which tract is excepted a small part sold to Robert Goodlett off of the north corner also fifty acres of land joining the above taken off of a tract of land granted to Thomas Lawrence the twenty sixth day of April 1786 making in the whole two hundred and fifty five acres excepting the part sold to Goodlett as aforesaid Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have had to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Alexander McKinney his heirs and assigns for ever and we the said William Mulin and John Mulin do hereby bind our selves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Alexander McKinney his heirs and assigns against our selves our heirs Executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully
