 -tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
 and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert Harrison
 his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators
 to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert Harrison
 his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof to wit my hand and seal this fifth day
 of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven and
 in the fifty first year of the Independence of the United States of America
