


South Carolina. Know all men by these presents. that I James Kilgore of Newbury
 district in the state aforesaid for and in consideration of fifteen hundred thirty
 dollars to me paid by Josiah Kilgore of Greenville District in the state aforesaid,
 have granted, bargained and sold & by these presents do grant, bargain
 & sell unto the said Josiah Kilgore all the following parcel or tract of
 land containing four hundred & twenty two acres more or less situate in
 Greenville District on Peters Creek of Enoree River beginning at a chestnut
 3x on the bank of said Creek & runs an oblique to the N. McCrarys line N. 24. 10. 40 E.
 to a holly 3x on the school house branch then up the meanders of said bran-
 ch to a white Oak 3x Henry Brockman corner thence S. P. Brockman line
 to a Post Oak 3x then N. 49 $\frac{1}{4}$. 10. 56. 25 to a Stake then on James Kilgores line 136.
 10. 47. 00 to a pine 3x then S. 62. E to a maple 3x Mary McCrarys corner then
 on her line to Peters Creek then down the meanders of said Creek to the
 beginning together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments &
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs and assigns forever and do
 hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever
 defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Josiah Kilgore his
 heirs & assigns against myself and any heirs & against every person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my
 hand and seal this 21st of November 1823 signed sealed & acknowledged
 in presence of test Benjamin Kilgore, John Moore, James Kilgore, 
 South Carolina. Personally appeared before me Benjamin Kilgore of
 Greenville District being duly sworn saith that he was present and saw
 James Kilgore sign seal and acknowledge the within instrument of
 writing for the uses & purposes therein mentioned & that he this depos-
 ant with John Moore in the presence of each other sign their names
 as witnesses to the same sworn to be before me this May 18th 1827.

 and district aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold & released and
 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Josiah
 Kilgore all that tract or parcel of land, containing eighty acres more
 or less situate in said district on the long branch Beginning at a stake on the
 long branch & runs on said Kilgores line N. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$. 14. 13. 00. to a stake S. 68. 10. 57.
 20 to a post oak 3x. 3x S. 19. E. 6. 50. to a black jack 3x then on Jacob Garrett line
 S. 85. E. 15. 00. to a pine S. 82. E. 14. 50. to a Pusimmon 3x S. 6. 4. E. 4. 50 to the long
 branch at a spring then down the meanders of the branch to the
 beginning together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
 & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
 appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to
 warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises
