





South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that we

 Creek a branch of middle Trygon River being the place where Daniel Ropf
 generally lived begining on a Chesnut on Thomas Hanford's line on the
 bank of the Creek and runing thence N. 37 E. 5 chains to a pine thence
 N. 30. W. to a black oak on Turpins line thence with his line S. 42. W. 27.
 ch. 50 links to a stake thence N. 48. W. 5. chains to a stake thence N. 42
 E. 2. 1 ch. 50. links to a post oak stump thence S. 2. W. 25 chains to a hickory
 grub near the waggon road thence S. 4. 7 W. 25. ch. to white oak on the
 bank of the Creek and thence down the meanders of same Creek to the
 begining containing by Estimation ninety Acres be the same more
 or less being all the part of a tract of 379 acres of land that lays
 on the North side of the Creek which was given by James Ropf
 Daniel Ropf and the said James Ropf purchased the said land
 from John Burk together with all and singular the rights
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to sd. premises belonging

 ever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs and Executors to warrant

 or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
 any part thereof In witness whereunto we have set our hands and
 seals this the 4 of Decemr AD One thousand eight hundred and
 twenty six and fifty first year of American Independence
