 with the branch to a chestnut thence with the said branch to a red  
 Oak thence with the said branch to a white Oak, thence N. 39 E. 26  
 to a Spanish Oak corner thence N. 70 E. 35 across the branch to a  
 pine, thence S. 29 E. 9 to a black Oak, thence N. 28.50 to a pine and thence  
 N. 5 E. 22.50 to the beginning including the whole of the last mentioned  
 Two and four as laid down upon the general plat of the land of said
