bargained, sold, released and Conveyed and by these presents do grant  
bargain, sell, release and Convey unto the said Dr. John Brittenden a  
certain tract, parcel or Lot of Land situated in the District of Greenville  
in the said State of South Carolina in the South East part of the Village  
of Greenville known in the plan of the said Village as laid out by me  
by the Number seventeen, N<sup>o</sup>. 17, Commencing at Col Fleming's corner an Stake that  
at a Stake, running thence N<sup>o</sup>. 16 W. one hundred and seventy feet to a Stake 3x.  
thence N<sup>o</sup>. 74 E three hundred feet to a Stake 3x. thence N<sup>o</sup>. 16 E one hundred and seventy  
feet to a Stake 3x. thence N<sup>o</sup>. 74 W. three hundred feet to the beginning Stake 3x. thence N<sup>o</sup>.  
74 W. three hundred feet to the beginning Stake corner To Have and to hold all and  
singular the said premises, lands tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
one belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the said Dr.  
John Brittenden his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and for ever defend the  
said premises with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances to the same  
belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Doctor John Brittenden his heirs and  
assigns for ever against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons claiming  
or to claim the same or any part thereof In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand and affixed my seal the first day of September in the year of our Lord one  
thousand eight hundred and twenty five and in the fifth year of the sovereign  
- and Independence of the United States of America signed sealed and  
in the presence of William Choice & Isaac S. Whitter Vardry McBee Esq.
