or less lying in Greenville district on a branch of Thompsons Bevadam Creek on the north
side of said creek Beginning at a pine corner running N. 60 E. 19. to a red oak thence
N. 19. 50 to a post oak thence N. 80 W. 29 to a stake thence S. 19 E. 36 to the beginning bounded
by line running N. E. by Joseph Thompson &c by Spartanburgh line N. W. by William Burys
land to E. by John Clements land and originally granted to Daniel Wilbanks together with
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-
ises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Lemuel Coffey his heirs and
assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators
to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
Lemuel Coffey his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against
Every person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
Part thereof Witness my hand and seal this ninth day of April one thousand
