for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars
to me in hand paid by Robinson M. Earle of the District of Pendleton and said
State the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and
sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Robinson M.
Earle a certain tract of land containing two hundred acres be the same more
or less situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on the branches
of the Golden Grove Creek Waters of Saluda River originally granted to John
Maxwell begining at a state corner running thence N. 42° E. 44.73 links to a Hickory
corner thence N. 48° W. 44.73 links to a post oak corner thence S. 42° W. 44.73 links to
a state corner thence S. 48° E. 44.73 links to the begining corner which will more fully appear
by having a Reference to the original Grant and Plat also one other tract of
land situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid adjoining the said
tract begining at a state corner thence S. 54° E. 47' chains 50 links to a state cor
ner on John Barnes line thence S. 30° W. to a post oak corner thence W. 80° W. 55' chains
to a state corner on Solvers line thence S. 18° W. 58' chains to a state corner on Salu
da River thence up the said River to Cedekah Hollans corner on a
state line N. 40° E. 48' chains 50 links to the begining corner on John Maxwell
line containing one hundred and twenty six acres and three quarters being part
of a tract of land originally granted to Ambrose Blackburn and James Han
son and Conveyed by him to Bransford Goodwin to have and to hold
the two before mentioned tracts of land. with their appurtenances to the
said Robinson M. Earle his heirs and assigns forever and to do hereby warrant
and forever will defend the before mentioned land and premises to the said
Robinson M. Earle his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and
against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever
be witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
fourth day of September 1819. signed sealed and delivered in presence
