 Samuel M. Murphy also of the District and State aforesaid as and be  
 for the sealing and delivery of these presents, have granted bargained  
 and sold and by these Presents do grant bargain and sell unto the  
 said Samuel M. Murphy, a certain female negro Slave named  
 Ame being about Fourteen years of age, to have and to hold the said  
 female negro Slave together with the future issue and increase unto him  
 the said Samuel M. Murphy his Executors, Administrators and assigns in  
 Trust always never the less, to and for the sole use benefit and  
 behoof of my said wife Elizabeth Vickers, and to and for no  
 other intent or purpose whatsoever, so that ~~she~~<sup>he</sup> shall in no wise be  
 answerable or liable for my debts, contracts or engagements but to be  
 wholly and entirely free and exempt there from And I the said Thomas  
 Vickers for myself my heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns the said  
 Samuel M. Murphy his Executors and Administrators, and assigns, in  
 Trust, as aforesaid will for ever warrant and defend in the premises  
 In Witness whereof I the said Thomas Vickers have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this tenth day of October in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty seven Signed sealed and  
 delivered in the presence of, (the word together with his future issue and increase being  
 previously interlined between the 12 and 13 lines from the bottom of the first page)
