presents that we Abraham Granger and Mary Granger of the
district of Greenville in the state aforesaid for and in consideration of the
sum of fifty dollars to us in hand paid by Spartan Goodlett of the dis-
trict and state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
Spartan Goodlett all that certain tract piece or parcel of land
situated in the district of Greenville in the said state being part
of a tract originally granted to Mary Parsons beginning on a
post oak on Sloans line thence N. E. 80.29 chains to a pine thence N. 10
East 16 chains and fifty links to a white oak on the side of a branch thence
up the meander of the said branch to a white oak corner thence the
same course to a Spanish Oak corner near the road leading to McCoole's
Shoals where the Spinning Factory now is thence to the beginning containing
ninety eight acres less the same more or less and being the same piece of
land that Thomas Edwards conveyed to the said Mary Granger by
deed dated the 16th day of August 1824 which is recorded in Book
"O" page 12 together with all and singular the rights members her
descendents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining To Have and to hold all and singu-
lar the premises before mentioned unto the said Spartan Good-
lett his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind
ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
Spartan Goodlett his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our
heirs and against every person who or may lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness above and
Seals this twenty fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
and eight hundred and twenty seven and in the fifty first year
