South Carolina Greenville District Articles of agreement made ³¹⁶
 between Richard Ward Sr. and George Ward his son that is to say the said Richard
 Ward Senr is to give George Ward one half of all his property to take care of said Richard
 Ward his life time, and to maintain him, all the lands he gives one half to his
 son George Ward and at his death I give all unto my son George the rights and titles
 of all my lands I have proportion of the plantation where I have live until my
 death only I give it in care to rent or cultivate it as he pleases in the way
 of supporting of me and my part of the stock the rest of the Benefit of the
 profits of the plantation is to go to the said George Ward and he to connect it to
 his own use, all stock and house hold an Kitchen furniture, and Farming
 Utencials tools of all descriptions, I give unto my son one half George Ward
 do Bind myself to pay every due attention unto my Father as a son ought to
 I do hold the still in my hands only my son George is to have the Benefit of the still
 I do agree to pay all my Fathers debts that is just all my debts that are owing to me
 are to be paid unto my son George Ward November the 4th day 1827 this signed
 And delivered in the presence of us the witness, Richard Ward
 Test. William S. Dill, Edward Stewart mark
