W H Salmon of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consider  
ation of the sum of three thousand dollars to me in hand paid by  
George Salmon of the same place the receipt of which is hereby ackno  
wledged I have this day Granted bargained, sold, Released conveyed  
and delivered and by these presents do grant, Bargain sell release, convey and  
Confirm unto the said George Salmon his heirs or assigns a planter  
Tract or Parcel of land containing six hundred and twenty eight  
Acres, be the same more or less situate in Greenville District aforesaid  
on the North East side of the North Fork of Saluda River and run  
ning as follows, viz. Beginning on a Hickory tree on the bank of said River  
at the mouth of an old ditch thence N. fifty six degrees E. twenty nine  
Chains to a poplar at the mouth of a ditch cut by Bartow thence N.  
Twenty one degrees E. eighteen chains to a Chestnut on a branch thence up  
the straight fork therof to the first fork be low a School House thence up  
the left fork of said branch to a marked white oak and state a crop  
the Road thence N. thirty three degrees W. Twenty chains to Rodins Red  
Oak corner thence the same course thirty three chains to Rodins Spanish Oak  
corner thence N. seventy five degrees W. sixteen chains to a maple on a branch  
therof down said branch to a Mountain Oak bushy corner thence S. thirty  
one and a half degrees E. twenty one chains to a Mountain Oak Mapoy's corner  
thence S. twenty degrees W. forty five chains and fifty links to a post oak  
Tally corner thence S. Fifty seven degrees W. twenty three chains to a
