 in the State aforesaid & district of Greenville wherein John Blacker now lives
 on the Rudy Fork of Rudy River containing four hundred acres the same
 more or less bounded by lines running from the Rudy Fork an James
 Harrison line N. 24 E. 47 to the main Road thence up said Road as it now
 runs, to Tanys line N. 37 W. 52 ch thence on Tanys line S. 2 E. 12.50 to a stake
 thence on said line S. 80 W. 80 to a stake 3x thence S. 2 E. 12.50 to a post oak 3x an
 Yedales line thence N. 80 E. 20 ch to the Rudy Fork thence down the same with
 the meanders to the beginning being part of four several tracts granted
 to John C. Kilpatrick, William Tisdale, Stephen Ford, and Owen Jenkins to have
 and to hold all and singular the premises above described, with all rights
 appurtenances, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise
 incident or appertaining, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Execu-
