James Taylor his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land  
containing two hundred and seventy acres be the same more or less  
situated in Groveville District lying on Both sides of Musc Creek  
being part a tract of five hundred acres of land granted to John  
Nichols by a grant bearing date the sixteenth day of July one thousand  
seven hundred and eighty four and by said John Nichols conveyed  
to myself Taining Flora Baswell, William Neaves, William P. Pool  
Alexander McKinney, John Taylor Peter Taylor and Archabold  
Taylor Jr containing two hundred and seventy acres aforesaid
