being originally granted to Randolph Casey by his Excellency Charles
Pinckney the 10th day of November 1790. Together with all and singular the
Rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises be-
longing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all & singular the said land & premises before mentioned unto the said Charles
Wood his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
