 sideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James
 Magness of the district and State aforesaid have granted bargan-
 gled sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and re-
 lease unto the said James Magness all that tract or parcel of land
Containing one hundred acres more or less situated lying and being
 in the district & State aforesaid on the waters of Enore River, it being a
 part of a tract of land Samuel Magness now has, or beginning
 on a hickory thence south to a Black jack thence East to a black oak
 thence a conditional line to a post oak, thence to the beginning corner
 Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said James Magness his heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
 and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said James Magness his heirs and assigns against myself
 and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this the fif-
 ty day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
 twenty five and in the forty ninth year of the American Independence
