 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William
 Brock all that tract of parcel of land, containing one hundred acres
 more or less, situate lying and being in the district aforesaid on the west
 side of Enore River, it being part of a tract of land whereon Samuel Mag-
 ness now lives beginning on a hickory, thence South to a black Oak
 thence East to a black Oak thence a conditional line to a post oak
 thence to the beginning corner. Also one other tract of land being and
 lying in said State and district beginning on a black Oak corner on
 Samuel Magness original line being corner to Thomas McGowan land
 thence running westwardly Meadow line, to a stake, on John Tramm-
 ell's thence Eastwardly on said line to a post oak corner, on the old
 road, thence Southwardly to a hickory, thence thence to the beginning
 Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or app-
 ertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said William Brock his heirs and
 assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and
 administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the
 premises aforesaid mentioned to the said William Brock his heirs and
 assigns against myself my heirs and every other person lawfully claiming
 the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have here unto
