Greenville District State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of  
the sum of five hundred dollars to him in hand paid by Eli Hunt of the District and  
State aforesaid have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and  
release unto the said Eli Hunt all that tract or parcel of land containing two hundred  
and eighty two acres being the same more or less being a tract of land originally granted  
to Mary White and a part of a tract of a tract formerly owned by James Woody  
beginning on an oak corner on the branch a hove West Still House thence up said  
branch to where the old road crosses sd branch thence with said old road to the  
original line being a conditional line made between Moses Finsley and the  
said Isaac West thence S. East to a post oak corner on Thurstons line thence  
S. E to a post oak corner thence S. course to a black oak corner thence a  
westerly course to the beginning oak corner together with all and singular the Rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the  
said premises a house mentioned unto the said Eli Hunt his heirs and assigns for  
ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to war  
rant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
Eli Hunt his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs and against every other  
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
In witness whereof I do hereby set my hand and affix my seal this fifth day of
