me in hand paid by Bechthland Butler of the district of Edgefield
and State aforesaid the receipt is hereby acknowledged have granted
bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain
sell and convey unto the said Bechthland Butler and his heirs for
ever a certain tract piece or parcel of land situated in Greenville
district and State aforesaid near Pike's Mountain containing fifty five
acres be the same more or less beginning at a Post oak near the
road leading from Capt. Gains to Pike's Mountain and running S 8
E. 33. 80. to a Chestnut corner thence S 54 E 24. links to a Spanish Oak cor-
ner thence N 80. W 55. chains to a chestnut corner near the said road
thence to the beginning; and also another tract adjoining the above
on the north side containing five acres be the same more or less
beginning at a Red oak near a Spring and running S. 80. 13 Ch. 60 links
cropping a branch to a white oak thence N. 10. E. 3. 60. to a Stake by a hick-
ory thence N. 80. W. cropping the Spring branch 13. 90 to a Stake thence S 10
W. 3 Ch. 60 links to the beginning making in both tracts, be the same more
or less fifty acres together with all and singular the rights, members
and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or
in any wise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Bechthland But-
ler her heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself and my
heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
singular the said premises unto the said Bechthland Butler and
her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every
other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
