 of land situated on the west side of Enoree River in the district and
 State aforesaid commencing at a dog wood on the north bank of Enoree
 River thence down the various meanders of said River to a maple
 in an old mill pond on the south side of said mill pond thence
 a strait line to a white Oak & thence to a white Oak & thence to a white
 oak on the bank of said River thence down the various meanders of said
 River to John Sawyer line thence west with said line 21 chains to a post oak
 corner thence North 25 degrees west with said line a crop the lever down to a
 a post oak corner or stake thence a strait line to the beginning it being a part
 of a tract originally granted to John Sawyer and is supposed to contain
 one hundred and sixty acres. be the same more or less together with all and sin-
 gular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-
 ises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Timothy
 H. Kuler his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself and
 my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said Timothy H. Kuler his heirs and assigns for ever again-
