 said Abraham Green all that plantation Tract or parcel of land situated  
 lying and being in Greenville District on the head waters of Musky creek  
 of ~~Greenville~~ River, and containing two hundred and Eleven acres be-  
 the same more or less it being a part of two tracts of land originally  
 granted to George Lewis and Moses Lewis, the grant to George Lewis  
 bearing date the 7 day of March 1796. and the grant to Moses Lewis  
 the 7<sup>th</sup> day of December 1795. then conveyed from said Moses Lewis to  
 George Lewis and from George Lewis to Aaron Kump and from said  
 Kump to Lewis Hamell then sold by Henry Tandy Walker Sheriff of  
 Greenville to Haratis Griffin and William Bowen and by them conveyed  
 to John J. Bulaw } together with all and singular the Rights, members  
 Hereditaments, and appurtenances, to the said Premises belonging or in  
 any wise incident or appertaining To Have and to hold all and sing-  
 - ular the premises before mentioned unto the said Abraham Green  
 his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs Ex-  
 - cutors and administrators, to warrant and for ever all and singular  
 the said premises unto the said Abraham Green his heirs and assigns
