sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and re-  
lease, unto the said Reuben Harrison all that plantation or tract of  
land originally granted to the said Reuben Harrison by grant bearing date  
the 19<sup>th</sup> May 1800. and by him conveyed to me by and bearing date the  
fifteenth day of March 1827 situated lying and being in the district of  
Grunville aforesaid, containing three hundred acres be the same more  
or less lying on Saluda River, and being the same tract wherein the  
said Reuben now lies, and for a particular description thereof  
reference to the grant must be had together with all and singular  
the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said pre-  
mises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto  
and to hold, all and singular the premises, before mentioned, unto the  
said Reuben Harrison his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind  
myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever  
defend, all and singular the said premises, unto the said Reuben Harrison  
his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every other  
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this Eleventh day of  
June in the year of our Lord an thousand Eight hundred and  
Twenty Eight and in the fifty second year of the Independence of the  
United States of America signed, sealed and delivered in the presence of
