State of South Carolina I have all men by these presents that I John Burns of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars paid by Jacob Glaze the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jacob Glaze a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less situate in the district and State aforesaid on a branch of Ecorse River beginning on a Stake at the old road thence a long way Basons line to a Spanish oak corner thence along Robert Basons & Mr Chambers line to a white oak corner thence down branch to the fork thereof the other fork to a large poplar thence to the road to a red oak corner thence along the road to the beginning corner being part of a tract of land granted to Robert Prince the second day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty six together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jacob Glaze his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Jacob Glaze his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and Administrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, to claim the same or any part thereof.
